

**NAME**

do - execute a command file

**SYNOPSIS**

do *command\_file*

do .

**DESCRIPTION**

The do macro reads commands contained in the ASCII file *command\_file*, echoing each command to the screen as it is read.

If the argument is a single dot (.), the previous command file is used.

The global variable DO\_DIR may be set to the name of directory that will be searched for *command\_file*, if *command\_file* is not in the current directory.

**EXAMPLE**

do do.scans

**GLOBAL VARIABLES**

DOFILE - Last command file used.

DO\_DIR - Name of private command file directory.
