

NAME

do – execute a command file

SYNOPSIS

```
do command_file
do .
```

DESCRIPTION

The `do` macro reads commands contained in the ASCII file *command_file*, echoing each command to the screen as it is read.

If the argument is a single dot (`.`), the previous command file is used.

The global variable `DO_DIR` may be set to the name of directory that will be searched for *command_file*, if *command_file* is not in the current directory.

EXAMPLE

```
do do.scans
```

GLOBAL VARIABLES

`DOFILE` – Last command file used.

`DO_DIR` – Name of private command file directory.
