

NAME

l - UNIX file listing

SYNOPSIS

```
l [options] [files ... ]
```

DESCRIPTION

The `l` macro executes the UNIX command `ls -l` in the current directory. Some of the more useful options to `ls` are:

- t Sort by last-modification time.
- u Sort by last-access time.
- r Reverse the sort order.
- R Recursively descend directories and list.

DEFINITION

```
def l 'unix("ls -l $*")'
```

EXAMPLE

```
l -ut do.*
```
