

NAME

lsdef - list current macros

SYNOPSIS

```
lsdef [pattern_name ... ]
```

DESCRIPTION

The command `lsdef` is used to list the names of the defined macros as well as their sizes in bytes. With no arguments, all the macro names are listed. Otherwise, only the macros specified as arguments are printed. Arguments may contain the `*` and `?` metacharacters.

EXAMPLE

```
lsdef *scan
```
