resume – continue an aborted scan

**SYNOPSIS**

resume [*n*|-*n*]

**DESCRIPTION**

The `resume` macro (also called `scan_on`) resumes a scan that was previously aborted. With a positive argument, *n* points are skipped. A negative argument redoes the previous *n* points.

For example, `resume -1` redoes the previous point, while `resume 3` skips the next three points. Giving a very large number will force the end-of-scan plots, etc., without taking any more data points.
